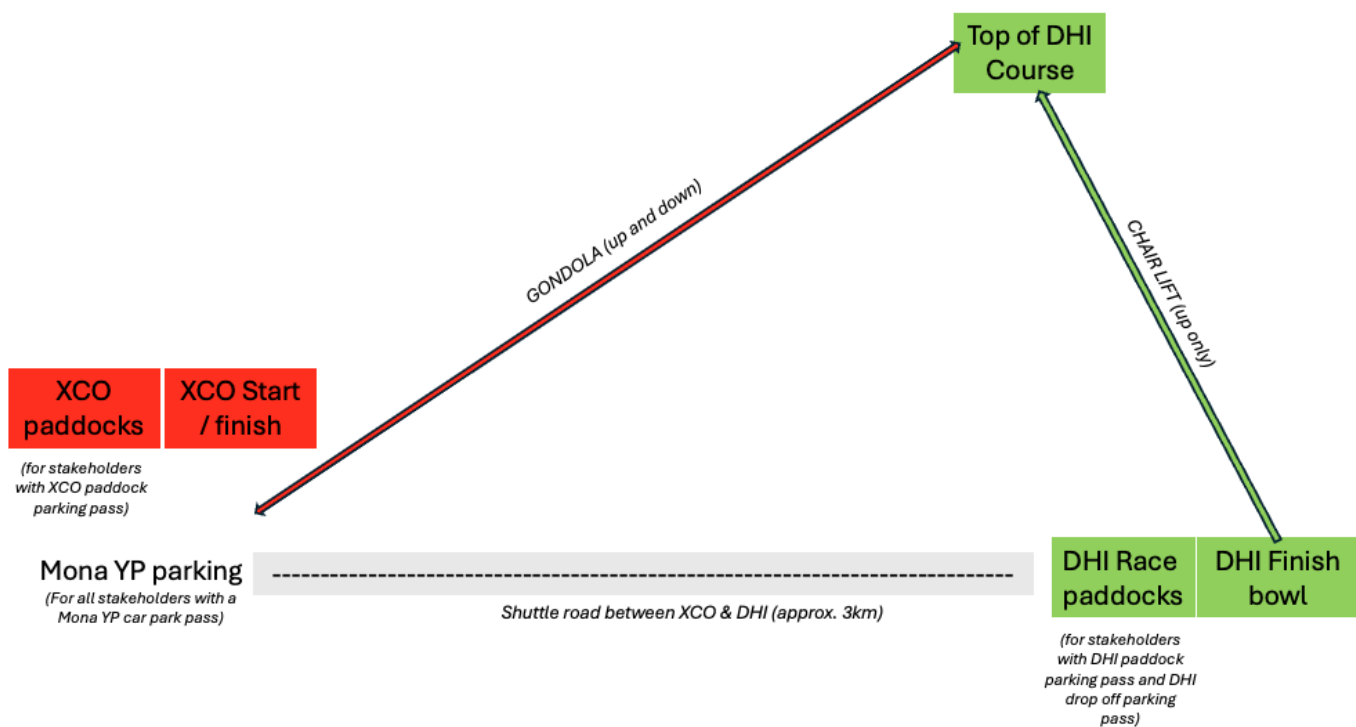
VEHICLE & CHAIRLIFT MOVEMENT

PARKING OVERVIEW

Please note, the South Korea venue is a split venue - the DHI race paddocks and XCO race paddocks are approx. 3km apart.

In South Korea all stakeholders will receive venue specific car parking passes. The vehicle allocation will match the contractual allocation.

However please note, there will be a **restricted** number of vehicles allowed to be to park at the **DHI paddocks** and any additional vehicles must be parked at the XCO venue (Mona YP parking). These restrictions will be managed by parking passes distributed at the start of week.



CHAIRLIFT & GONDOLA ACCESS

- There is a chair lift from the DHI race paddocks to the start of the DHI course - this can carry people up the mountain, **but not down**
- There is a gondola from the XCO venue to the top of the DHI course - this can carry people **up and down** the mountain

Stakeholders at DHI race paddocks can use the chairlift to get up to the DHI start, but must use the gondola to get back down. They can then use their team vehicle, or the LOC arranged shuttle to drive back to the DHI race paddocks.

DHI PADDOCK PARKING

This pass allows the vehicle to enter paddock and park next to the stakeholder's booth / paddock set up through out the day. It must remain stationary when vehicle movement is prohibited.

**Vehicle movement within the paddock is prohibited between: 8.30 to 19.00pm
Thursday - Saturday**

DHI PADDOCK DROP OFF PARKING

This pass allows vehicles into the paddock when vehicle movement is permitted. They can drop off people and equipment directly outside their booth / paddock set up before parking in the small carpark 50m from the race paddock

MONY YP PARKING

This pass allows vehicles to park in the Mona YP carpark next to the XCO venue. It also allows the vehicle to shuttle between the venues during event week, utilizing the drop off zone just outside the race paddocks.

Vehicles with this pass are not permitted in the race paddock.

XCO PADDOCK PARKING

This pass allows the vehicle to enter paddock and park next to the stakeholder's booth / paddock set up through out the day. It must remain stationary when vehicle movement is prohibited.

Vehicle movement within the paddock is prohibited between: 8.30 to 19.00pm, Thursday to Sunday.

STAKEHOLDERS BASED IN THE DHI VENUE

Those stakeholders based at the DHI venue can use vehicles with a Mona YP parking pass and shuttle themselves between the DHI race paddocks and the Mona YP carpark as much as they need to during the event week.

These vehicles are not permitted to enter the paddocks and instead must utilise the drop off zone next to the DHI race paddocks.

Vehicles must not remain parked for more than 5 minutes, to allow other vehicles to access the zone as well.

Paddock Protocols

Please note that the stakeholders shall be subject to the following sanctions by WBD Sports for any of the following breaches.

Removal of accreditation and / or bibs:

- Poor behaviour towards WBD Sports or Local Event Organiser staff, including but not limited to abusive or threatening language
- Jumping barriers
- Blocking live cameras
- Passing on of bibs will result in removal of bib
- Passing on of accreditation

Fines:

WHOOPE UCI MTB World Series teams & Paddock Partners only

- Early departure from paddock = EUR 1000
- Late arrival into Team area = EUR 1000
- Late paddock booking = EUR 1000
- Bike washing in the paddock area = EUR250
- Late or no return of transponders = EUR100
- Late or no return of GPS trackers = EUR250
- Exceeding booked space = EUR50 per m2
- Damage to equipment, or venue infrastructure = Team to make payment to WBD Sports of cost of replacement, or rectification of damage (as WBD Sports deems fit)
